

Athletic Eligibility

- Pass 20 units – (4 classes) – Only 1 class can be in PE / Athletics (must be enrolled in 20 units).
- Overall Grade point average – 2.0
- One probationary period allowed during the athlete's 4 year career
- Eligibility determined from the previous 9 week grading period

Students whose previous year of high school was not at Northwood should immediately notify the coach and see the Athletic Director so that CIF paperwork can be processed and they can be eligible to play.

Athletic eligibility is first established when the student enters 9th grade. Students entering 9th grade must meet all academic and citizenship requirements of the CIF.

Anytime a student moves from one school to another, the student is considered a “transfer” student. There will be paperwork (forms and documentation) that the student and his/her parents/legal guardians will have to complete in order to request athletic eligibility. The new school will communicate with the transfer student's previous school and work with the parents to complete the necessary forms to ensure not only residential eligibility but also academic eligibility.
